



## MATERIAL LIST

### Required:

- 1 short invisible zipper (e.g. 5 inches long)
- At least 2 additional short zippers (e.g. 5 inches long)
- At least 6 buttons (any size)
  
- Straight pins
- Hand sewing needle
- Seam ripper
- 2 yards of woven fabric of your choice. This fabric will be used to create samples, so go with something affordable. e.g. you could buy cotton muslin.
- 2 spools of thread. I recommend colour(s) that contrast with your fabric.
  
- Clear tape
- A pen or marker
- A pencil
  
- Something to mark fabric with such as:
  - Frixion pen
  - Erasable/Fast-Fade marker
  - Tailor's wax
  - Tailor's chalk
  - Heart wheel

### Optional:

- Fabric scissors (if you plan to continue sewing beyond this class, I highly recommend investing in a good pair of shears, e.g. Dragonfly – <https://sewingsupplydepot.com/collections/scissors/products/dragonfly-tailoring-shears>)
- Thread snips/thread scissors
- Paper scissors or exacto knife
- Needle threader
- Pincushion
- A measuring tape
- A straight ruler (a 2 inch by 18 inch C-thru ruler works particularly well)
