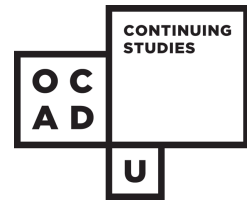

MATERIAL LIST

09/2022

Required:

- Straight pins
- Seam ripper (I like Clover, which can be bought at Leather & Sewing Depot, World Sew Centre, and the Workroom)
- Thread (I like Gütermann thread, which can be bought at many sewing supply stores, e.g. Leather & Sewing Supply Depot, World Sew Centre)
- Fabric of your choice (can be bought after the first class)

- A Button
- A zipper, at least 6 inches long

- Something to mark fabric with such as:
 - Frixion pen
 - Erasable/Fast-Fade marker
 - Tailor's wax
 - Tailor's chalk
 - Heart wheel

Optional:

- Seam Roller (a wooden, metal, or rubber tool used to flatten and open up seams instead of an iron)
- Needles
- Needle threader
- Pincushion
- Paper scissors
- Fabric scissors
- Thread snips/thread scissors
- A measuring tape
- A straight ruler (2 inch by 18 inch C-thru ruler works particularly well)
