For this course you may choose to purchase **either** acrylic paints **or** oil paints.

Oil or Acrylic Tube Paints, 38 ml: Colour List

- Cadmium Red, Medium Hue
- Alizarine crimson
- Cadmium Yellow, Medium Hue
- Cadmium Yellow Deep Hue
- Ultramarine Blue
- Cerulean Blue
- Ivory Black
- Titanium White
- Raw Umber

Recommended Colours:

- Burnt Sienna
- Burnt Umber
- Yellow Ochre

NOTE: If you choose oil paint also purchase a container of acrylic paint in Burnt Sienna for under-painting. You are welcome to include other colours you already own in your palette, keeping in mind colour mixes will vary with different pigments.

Brushes:

- 6 long handle brushes in an assortment of sizes. Try to get a mix of small, and medium in flats, or filberts with a small round brush for details and a larger flat brush for underpainting. Your range should fall somewhere between sizes 2 and 8.
- Palette knife

NOTE: Bristle brushes will leave more texture, synthetic and soft brushes will leave smoother marks.

Suggested Grounds:

- 5 Canvas boards, 8" x 10" – 9"x12" or a pad of primed canvas paper 9"x12" (you may use a combination of the two if you choose)
- 1 larger surface, either a canvas board or stretched canvas at least 14"x18" or larger.

Others:

- Container for medium with a watertight lid (yogurt containers for acrylic, or old glass jars for oil)
- Small bottle of linseed oil (for oil) **or** small bottle of glazing medium (for acrylic)
- Pad of palette paper
- Pencil (or white or yellow pencil crayon)
- Eraser
- Masking tape
- Old rag (such as an old t-shirt or towel)
- Painting support such as a drawing board, piece of masonite, plywood, table, easel etc. basically a rigid surface you can paint on.

Estimated Total Cost of Supplies: \$95
