#### Paints: Watercolour 8ml Tubes

- Alizarin Crimson
- Ultramarine Blue
- Cadmium Yellow Hue
- Cadmium Red Med Hue
- Phthalo Blue
- Lemon Yellow

# Suggested, but not required paints:

- Yellow Ochre
- Burnt Umber
- Burnt Sienna
- Viridian Hue
- Raw Umber
- Chinese White
- Cadmium Orange Hue
- Cerulean Blue
- x 1 tube of white gouache

### **Brushes: Watercolour Brushes**


- 1" or ¾" flats
- A range of round brushes in different sizes, at least 3. (ex. a #4, #6, and #10)
- A fine/ small brush for masking fluid (an old or inexpensive brush is best)

### **Surfaces:**

- A pad or block of cold pressed 140lb watercolour paper 9"x12" (minimum 12 sheets)
- A piece of Masonite or drawing board (16"x20"ish) make sure it is at least a few inches larger than your paper.

### Other Tools:

- A pallet with at least 10 wells and good-sized mixing areas
- x2 jars/containers for water



- Paper towels (a Swedish dish cloth may be supplemented for a more reusable option)
- Cloth rag
- Artist tape/ painters' tape (suitable for use on paper)
- Kneaded eraser
- Graphite pencil, 4H
- Scissors or X-acto knife/ box cutter
- 12" ruler
- Masking fluid (if you have sensitivities to latex, please use a latex free variety)

## Suggested, but not required materials:

- Sea sponge/ sponge
- Small misting spray bottle
- Eye dropper
- Toothbrush
- Water-soluble/watercolour pencils
- Water tank brush
- A couple more jars or containers for water/ washes

Note: You are welcome to include other colours and materials that you already own in your supplies, keeping in mind colour mixes will vary with different pigments. Demonstrations will be made using colours listed. If you have any questions about specific materials, please let me know.
