The below materials are available at Aboveground Art Supplies, but all reputable art supply stores will have equivalent products.

Watercolour Paints:

- Phthalo Blue
- Ultramarine Blue
- Cadmium yellow hue
- Yellow Ochre
- Cadmium Red Light hue
- Alizarin Crimson hue
- Burnt Umber

*Winsor & Newton Cotman 8ml. (\$4.39 ea.) are a good, budget-oriented brand. Be sure to look for “hues” rather than pure pigments if on a budget.

Watercolour Brushes:

The below are a suggested minimum selection (from aboveground Art Supplies), but any combination of watermedia **flats** (Rectangular heads), **filberts** (oval heads) **and rounds** (pointed heads) that cover a range of sizes are acceptable.

- ABOVEGROUND #4 round SH (orange handle)
- ABOVEGROUND #10 round SH(orange handle)
- ABOVEGROUND 3/4” flat (orange handle)
- Winsor & Newton Cotman 3/8" Filbert (blue handle)

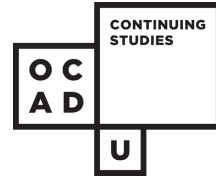
Paper:

The below are suggestions. You are free to buy larger pads or sheets. Cold pressed paper is suggested.

- Winsor & Newton Watercolor pad pad, 140 lb, 10"x14", 12 sheets
 - * Similar sizes are acceptable, but ensure the paper is cold press and 140lb min.
 - * Individual sheets of cold press watercolour paper are acceptable

Other:

- Graphite Pencil, HB or 2H
- Pencil sharpener (or utility knife)
- White eraser
- Small sponge



- Plastic Palette - 9 well (or a large plastic surface for mixing)
- Large plastic containers/cups for holding water (disposable coffee cups are a good alternative)
- Cloth rags for brush cleaning
- Masonite or other non-porous board, at least 2" wider than the paper
- Steel ruler "15 (optional)
- Butcher tape (optional)
- Fold back or Bulldog clips (1" or larger)
- Masking fluid/frisket aprox. 45ml (optional)
